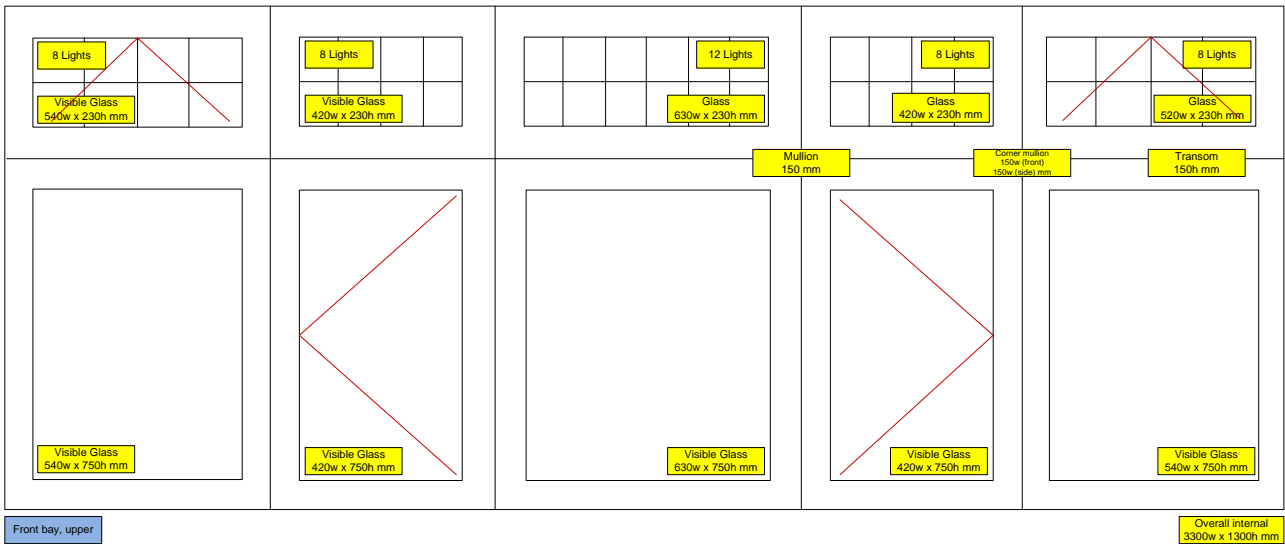


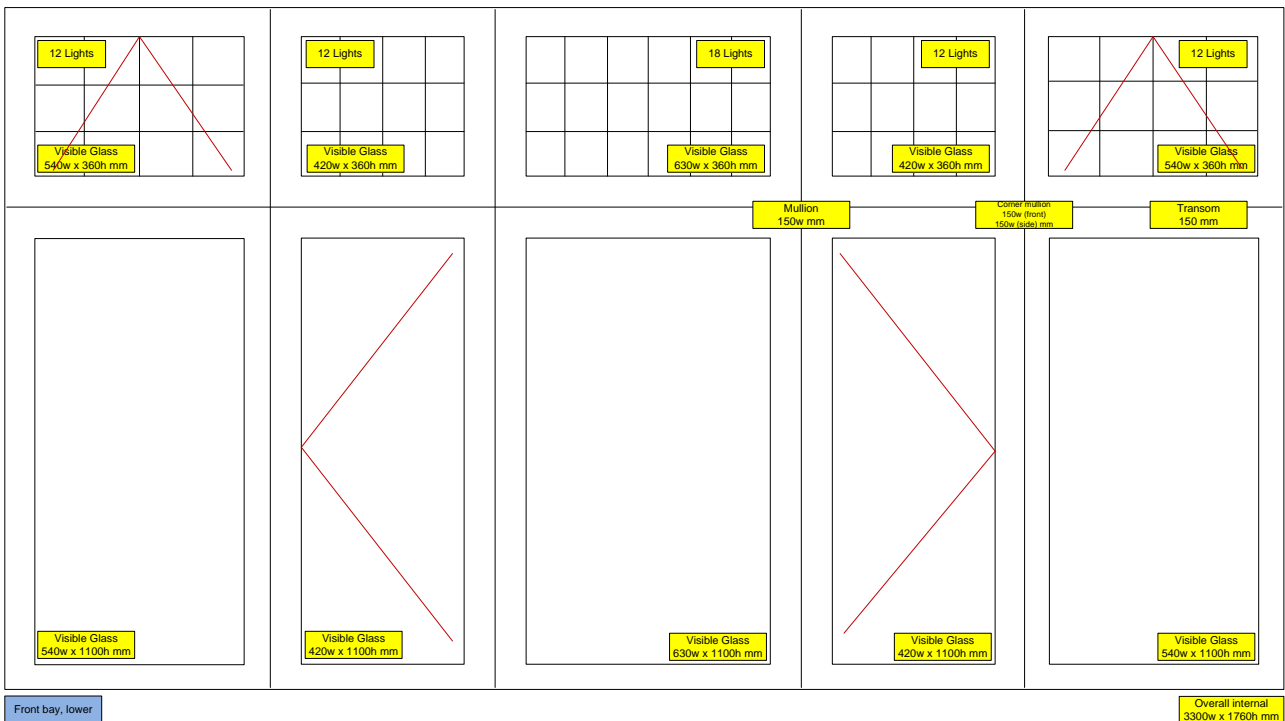


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Window Type 'A' Traditional House Types



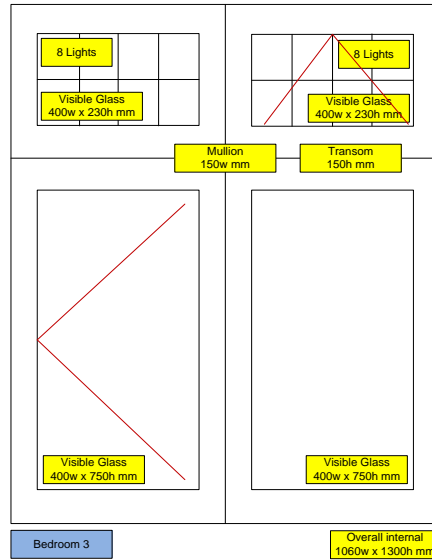
Front Elevation First Floor Bay – Bedroom 1



Front Elevation Ground Floor Bay – Lounge



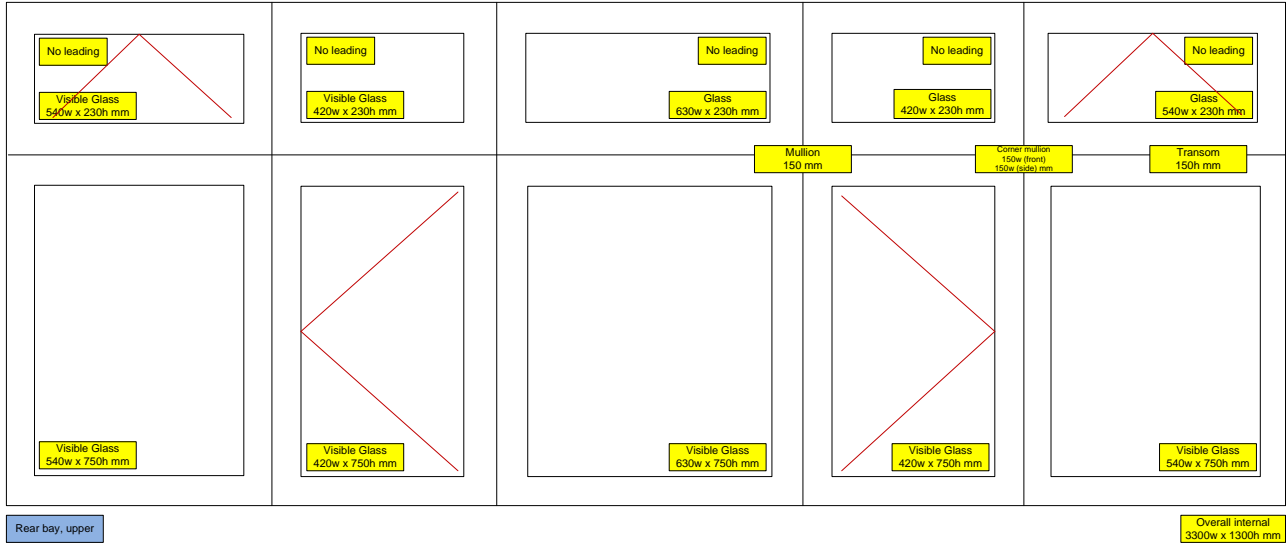
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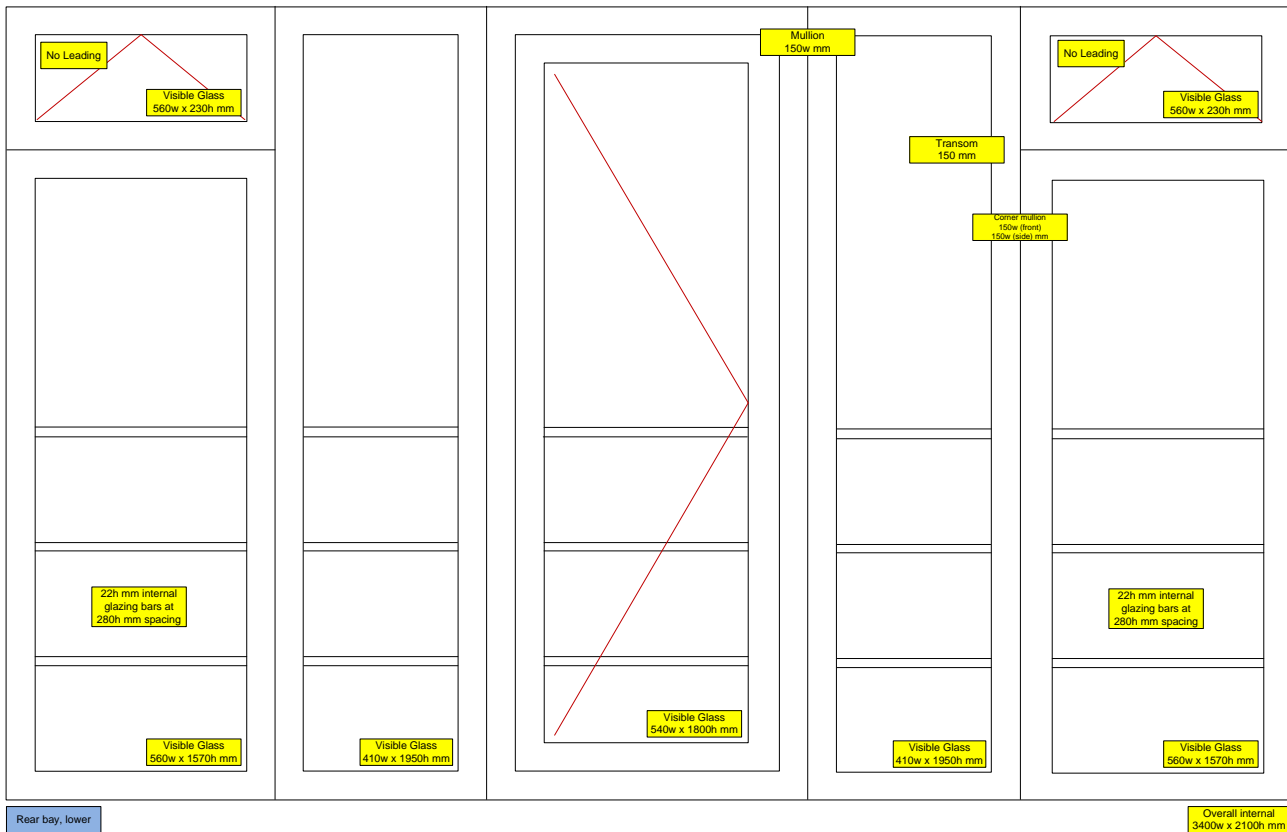
Front Elevation First Floor – Bedroom 3



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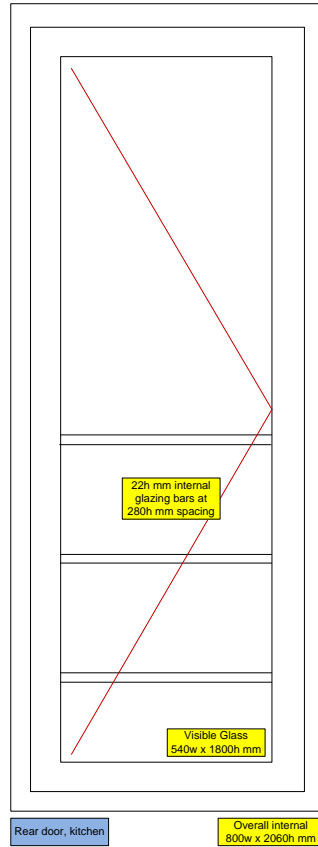
Rear Elevation First Floor Bay – Bedroom 2



Rear Elevation Ground Floor Bay – Lounge



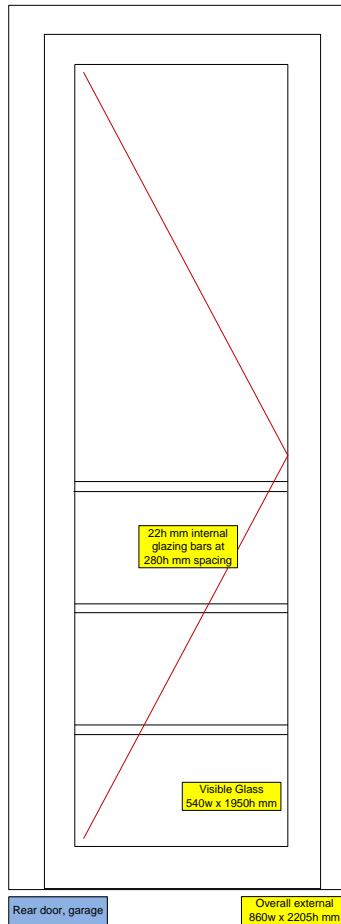
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Rear Elevation Ground Floor – Kitchen Door



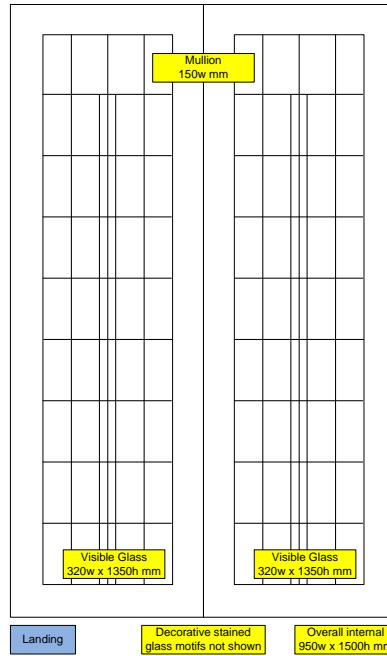
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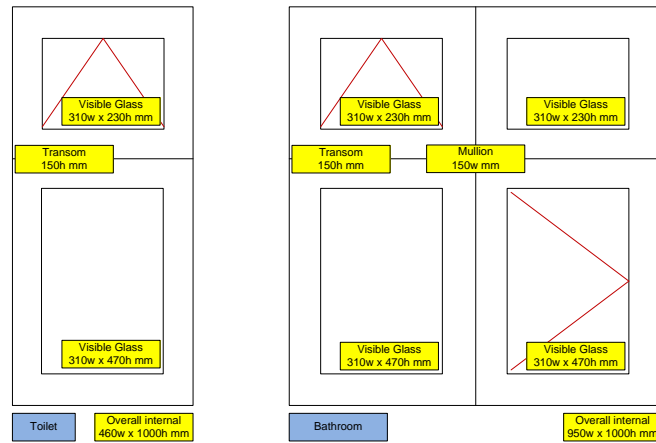
Rear Elevation Ground Floor – Garage Door



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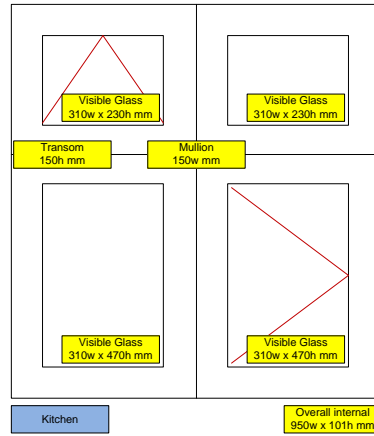
Side Elevation First Floor – Landing

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- All windows are drawn to a scale of 1:20
- The measurements shown are reasonably accurate within building tolerances. Residents should obtain verification of measurements by the window surveyor to ensure the windows installed accurately replicate the original designs and proportion. Windows should be made to fit the window apertures of the actual building
- The mullion and transom positions are important to the overall visual proportion of the windows. With reference to the transoms, the visible glass depth of the fanlights to the front ground floor bay window should be 360mm and elsewhere should be 230mm
- Drawings are a representation of a (Sutton Windows *) equal sight-line design featuring 150mm mullions and transoms and 75mm surround frame. * Other companies are available and the Association makes no recommendations as to suppliers
- Drawings are intended for properties with the front door to the left when viewed externally from the street. For properties with the front door to the right, the fixed window of bedroom 3 is the opener and is hinged to the right
- The hinge arrangements shown are as per the original Crittall windows and are as viewed externally, from the street
- The toilet, bathroom and kitchen windows were glazed in Arctic pattern glass. Minster pattern glass is a reasonable alternative
- The landing window was glazed in Small Flemish pattern glass. Small Flemish is no longer available. The nearest equivalent is Minster pattern glass. Large Flemish is available but looks quite different and has a very low obscurity rating.
